



The survey will be administered online and will take less than 20 minutes to complete. Please note that all survey information is confidential. Each school in the district must have 20% of eligible parents participate for a parent report to be generated. 




Announcements: CMMS Electronic Announcement Board










Students in Design Tech created a Universal Design Game for children with Cerebral Palsy to use in Physical Occupational Therapy.

- ID's: All students received a color coded ID and lanyard. It is the student's responsibility to wear both around their neck at all times during the school day and on our buses. Your account will automatically be charged \$5 every time a replacement ID/lanyard needs to be issued.
