





The survey will be administered online and will take less than 20 minutes to complete. Please note that all survey information is confidential. Each school in the district must have 20% of eligible parents participate for a parent report to be generated. AtL: D.I.C.E.

One of the AtL skills practiced in advisory this month is **D.I.C.E.** This stands for describe, infer, context, and evaluate. Students will practice describing what they see or read. Based on what they see or read they will infer the what, why, how, etc. They will discuss how context, using their own knowledge to make sense of something, can help them infer. Finally they will tie in the evaluate stage which is when they evaluate the source of the information. These skills are important tools that can be used across multiple curricular subjects.

Global Context: Orientation in Space & Time

Students will explore:

- Personal histories
- Turning points in humankind
- Explorations and migrations of humankind
- The relationships between and the interconnectedness of individuals and civilizations, from personal, local and global perspectives

Ask your student:

1. What is something you have learned this week that relates to one of these explorations?



IMPORTANT REMINDERS:

- ID's: All students received a color coded ID and lanyard. It is the student's responsibility to wear both around their neck at all times during the school day and on our buses. Your account will automatically be charged \$5 every time a replacement ID/lanyard needs to be issued.
- Clear Backpacks: ALL students are required to use a clear backpack. Please make sure your child is following our: CMMS Backpack Expectations.

- Activity Busses (4:15 p.m) will be available for students who are participating in any of our after school athletics, clubs or activities. Please note that your child will not be dropped off at their usual spot, but rather a close location in your neighborhood.
