On Friday, March 3 students who did not complete a direct service such as volunteering presented in the Make Them Care Fair. This event allowed students to raise awareness and/or advocate for a cause they felt strongly about. Students will reflect on the impact of their service during the next couple of weeks and present a final reflection piece to their advisory classes.



Service in Action!! On Tuesday, March 7, CMMS National Junior Honor Society took a field trip to Feed My Starving Children in Aurora. Students had a great time serving others by hand-packing nutritious MannaPack meals designed to assist in reversing and preventing undernutrition. The meals are distributed in schools, orphanages, clinics, and feeding programs around the world to deliver hope and break the cycle of poverty. While NJHS was there, we helped pack 81 boxes, which includes 17,496 meals. Our three hours of work will feed 48 kids for one year! Special thanks to the parent

volunteers who chaperoned for helping to make this possible.

The survey results are reported on the school report cards that are available to parents.

The parent survey is available from January 24, 2023, through March 31, 2023. All district parents are encouraged to take the survey. Your identity and your child's survey responses will be kept completely confidential and will never be connected to you or your child. The survey will be administered online and will take less than 20 minutes to complete. Please note that all survey information is confidential. Each school in the district must have 20% of eligible parents participate for a parent report to be generated. 

#### **IMPORTANT REMINDERS:**
