
#### Picture Day is on Tuesday, 9/26/23!!


### 2023 CMMS WARRIOR CROSS COUNTRY




#### **KEY REMINDERS:**

- ID's: All students received a color coded ID and lanyard. It is the student's responsibility to wear both around their neck at all times during the school day and on our buses. Your account will automatically be charged \$5 every time a replacement ID/lanyard needs to be issued.
- Clear Backpacks: ALL students have received their school issued CLEAR Backpacks. CMMS Backpack
   Expectations were reviewed and all students received a physical copy as well. Every student has the same backpack, so to help with any confusion, we welcome your child individualizing their bag by adding a distinctive sticker or name tag to their backpack.
- <u>Cell Phones</u>: All cell phones and non-school issued electronic devices need to be turned off and put away during the school day. Students who fail to adhere to this expectation will be subject to Board sanctioned consequences.

- **Chromebooks:** Students are expected to bring their charged chromebook daily. If your child has LOST their charger, please purchase a replacement on Amazon. Click on the appropriate grade level to go straight to the website.

- 6th Grade & New Student Physicals: An updated physical and vaccination record needs to be submitted at the start of 6th Grade. Please take care of completing this requirement prior to the start of school. Please understand that if your documentation is not turned in <a href="mailto:by Friday">by Friday</a>, October 13th your child will be excluded (not allowed to attend) school <a href="mailto:starting-on-Monday">starting-on-Monday</a>, October 16th and will remain as an unexcused absence until the appropriate documentation is turned in. This is part of the IL State Code.

- Water Bottles: We have bottle fillers located throughout the building. It is up to your child to bring in a filled OR refillable water bottle from home, particularly on hot days. Please make sure your child's name is clearly written on their bottle.
