During conferences, teachers will be able to go over individual students' grades, NWEA/MAP data and discuss your child's goal setting and academic progress so far this year.





KEY REMINDERS:

- ID's: All students received a color coded ID and lanyard. It is the student's responsibility to wear both around their neck at all times during the school day and on our buses. Your account will automatically be charged \$5 every time a replacement ID/lanyard needs to be issued.
- <u>Clear Backpacks</u>: ALL students have received their school issued CLEAR Backpacks. <u>CMMS Backpack</u>


