


Week 18: January 12, 2024



CMMS Athletics Spectator & Guest Info



E-Learning Day Reminders


This week we have seen our fair share of inclement weather! Please take a moment to review this important information! Every effort will be made to announce an E-Learning Day before the end of the school day. If the emergency does not allow the decision to be made in a timely manner, CM 201-U may use a traditional emergency day "snow day". We will then add the day to the end of the year as necessary. Students and staff are encouraged to return daily with a charged electronic device.

- Parents and families will be notified through standard modes of communication, including School Messenger, the district website, social media, and email.
- All K-12 students and staff must bring their device home daily.
- Google Classroom will be used to facilitate instruction.

E-LEARNING STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

- Students will check in with their teachers each period for the scheduled school day. Hop onto google meets for each class for attendance.
- Students complete the daily assigned lessons by the end of the E-Learning day.
- Students will bring home their devices daily.
- Check Google Classroom for every class & complete assigned tasks.
- Communicate with teachers via email if they encounter any problems when trying to complete assignments.




KEY REMINDERS:

- **ID's**: All students received a color coded ID and lanyard. It is the student's responsibility to wear both around their neck at all times during the school day and on our buses. Your account will automatically be charged \$5 every time a replacement ID/lanyard needs to be issued.
- <u>Clear Backpacks</u>: ALL students have received their school issued CLEAR Backpacks. <u>CMMS Backpack Expectations</u> were reviewed and all students received a physical copy as well. Every student has the same backpack, so to help with any confusion, we welcome your child individualizing their bag by adding a distinctive sticker or name tag to their backpack.
- <u>Cell Phones</u>: All cell phones and non-school issued electronic devices need to be turned off and put away during the school day. Students who fail to adhere to this expectation will be subject to Board sanctioned consequences.
