

## Ms. Shoun's Classroom Expectations

Welcome back! This is going to be a fun and exciting year. I am looking forward to challenging you, and ensuring that you are a successful Health student. However, I am going to need you to work as hard as you can while you are with me to achieve this goal. Here are some expectations to assist you in reaching this goal.

### Entering the classroom:

- Unless the teacher directs to otherwise, you are to enter the classroom quietly, be seated in your assigned seat and begin the Bell Ringer posted. If you finished early, get yourself organized for class- clear your desk of unnecessary supplies.

### Leaving the classroom:

-Remain seated until the teacher dismisses the class.  
-Make sure your work area is cleaned up and in order before leaving the room.  
-When exiting the classroom, you are expected to walk and remain at a voice level consistent with the hallway expectation, Level 1.

### Passes during class:

Passes are written for emergency purposes only. Forgetting something in your locker happens, but it will not be considered an emergency.

### Conduct in class:

- \*come to class prepared, on time, and ready to learn (planner, pen/pencil, paper, workbook)
- \*give your best effort each and every day
- \* ask for help when needed

- \*abide by the voice level set by the teacher for the given activity

- \* respect all materials/tools/furniture in the classroom, and only use them for their intended purpose(s)
- \*remain silent, in your seat, and focused while instruction is taking place
- \* only leave your seat when necessary (sharpening pencils, getting Kleenex, etc.)
- \* make good use of your time in class
- \* raise their hand and wait to be acknowledged before asking or answering questions
- \* make good choices, and think about the consequences of those choices (good and bad)

### Assessments:
