Dear Crete-Monee 201U Families,

Greetings! Let me be one of the first to congratulate you and your proud graduate and welcome you to the Crete-Monee High School Class of '23 family! You are now officially a part of the *Warrior Nation!* My name is Taurus Scurlock and I teach both Advanced Placement Seminar and freshmen Social Studies in addition to coaching freshman football at the high school. This summer, I will also serve as the Coordinator for Summer School at CMHS. You are receiving this letter because your child is currently enrolled, or will be enrolling in Advanced Placement courses at CMHS. To that end, we want your child to be successful in AP courses because it is an added benefit to both the student and the parent. *First*, the student, if successful, will gain college credit through the AP Testing and College Board. Secondly, if your child is successful in earning college credit through AP Testing and College Board, it is a bonus benefit for you as a parent because you can save thousands of dollars in tuition costs since your child has satisfactorily tested out of some college courses. To this end, we have designed a free course for in-district students that will assist your child in achieving success! The course is entitled: *Introduction to Advanced Placement Courses*.

This course is not required and it carries no graduation credit, but it will introduce your child to the specific skills necessary to 1) be successful in freshmen AP courses, and 2) successfully pass the AP Test for college credit. The course is offered in the second session of summer school and is slated to meet Monday-Thursday July 8th-July 25th from 8:00 am to 12:00 pm.
